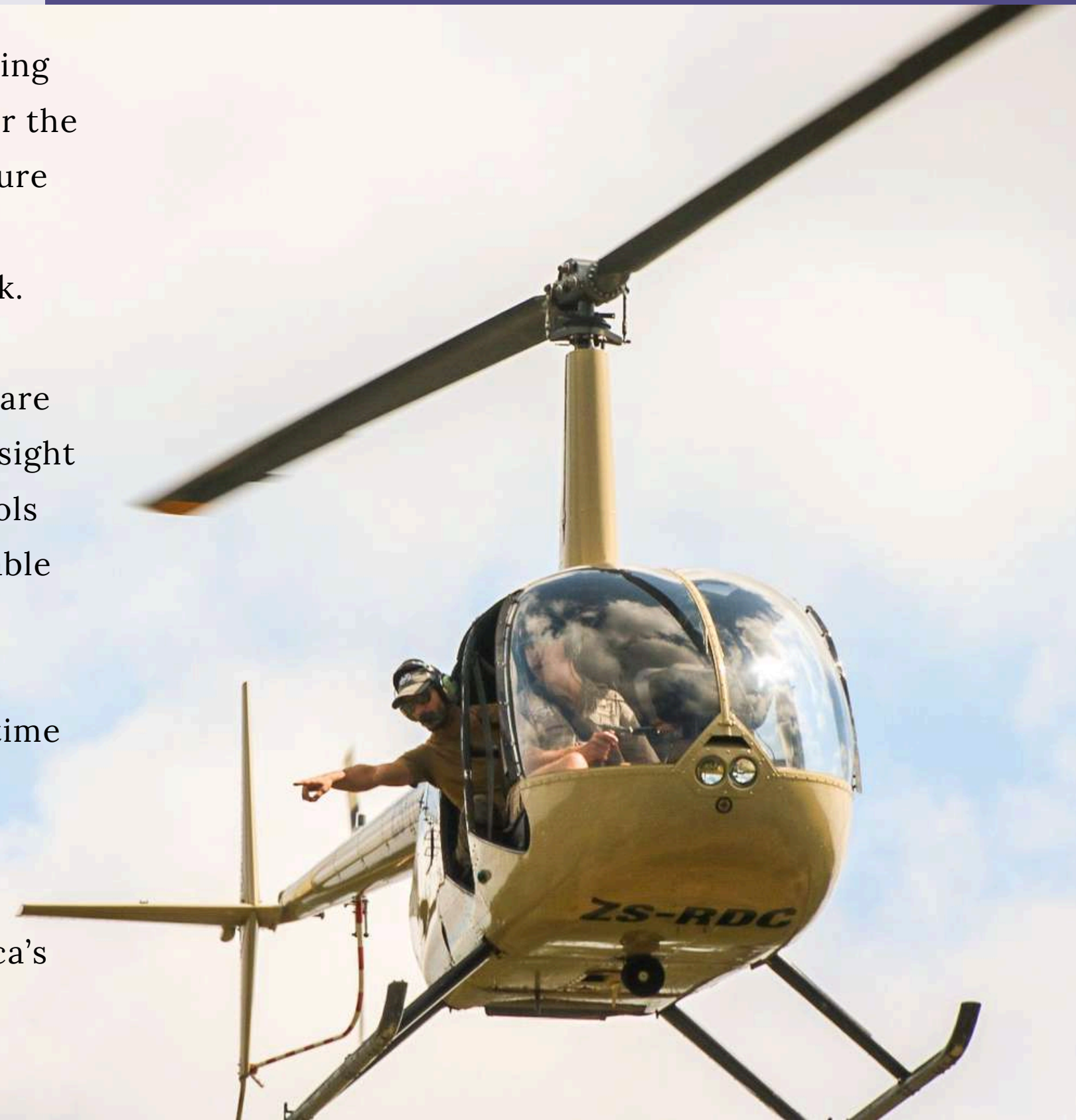
COUNTER-POACHING PATROL FLIGHT



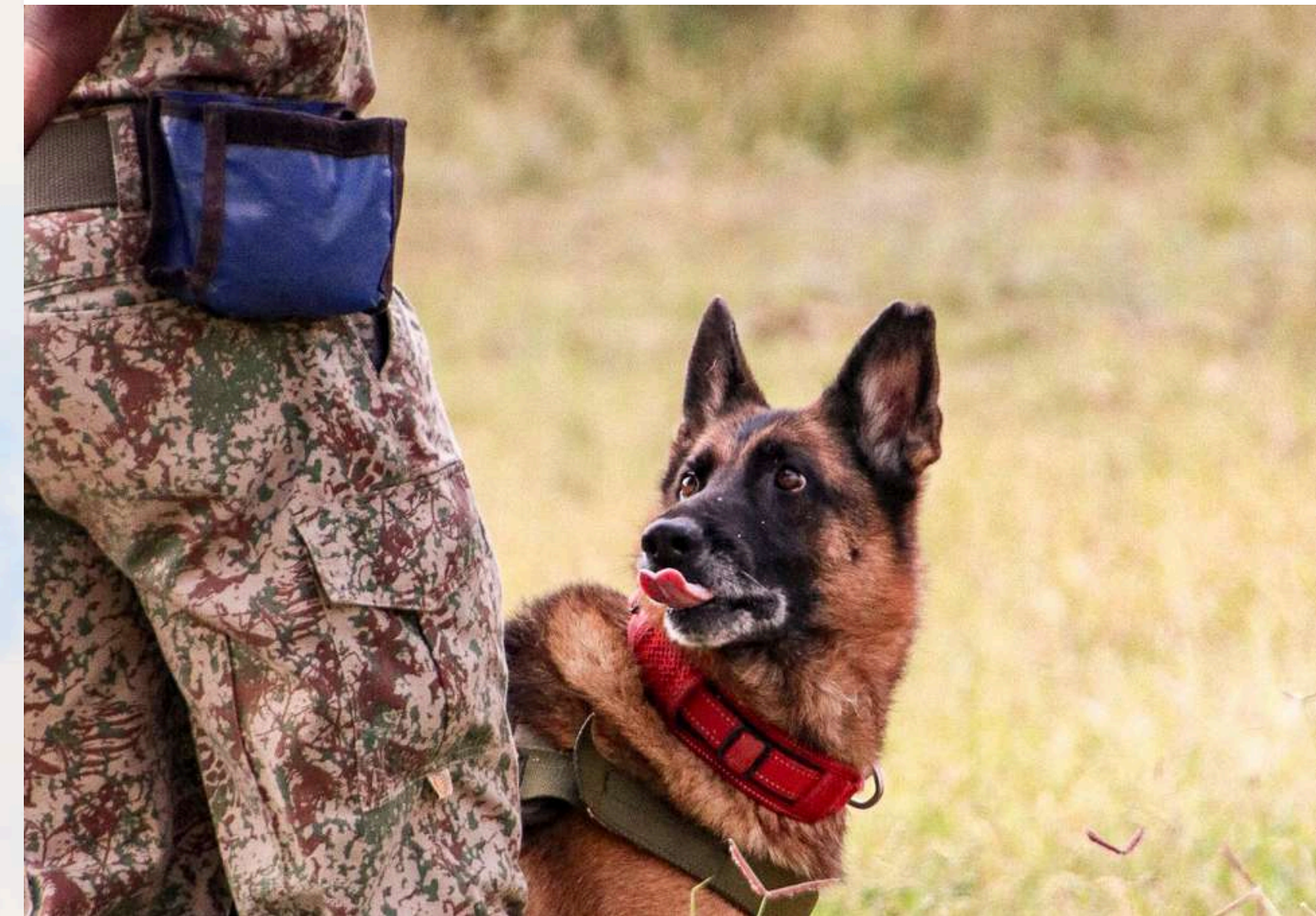
K9 EXPERIENCE

Join a counterpoaching helicopter flight over the Klaserie Private Nature Reserve and witness conservation at work. Led by the reserve's security team, this rare experience offers insight into how aerial patrols help protect vulnerable wildlife.

It's a once-in-a-lifetime flight with a lasting impact – directly supporting the preservation of Africa's natural heritage.



Wildlife conservation dogs are a powerful frontline defence, trained to detect threats and track criminal activity in ways no technology can match. The KPNR K9 Experience raises vital funds to support the care, safety, and long-term sustainability of the reserve's K9 unit.

- ▶ Guest briefing by the vet conducting the operation including important information pertaining to the Rhino, and this Counter-Poaching initiative along with details of the veterinary procedure to be undertaken.
- ▶ The vet and a few privileged guests will join the pilot in searching for, and darting, a suitable Rhino from the air.
- ▶ Guests will be driven to where the Rhino is immobilised, to participate in and assist the vet with this important conservation procedure.
- ▶ Guests will be invited to carry out important "hands-on" individual tasks in this veterinary and ecological process.
- ▶ When the veterinary and ecological process is completed, guests will enjoy an 'up close-and-personal' experience, including individual and group photographs, with the Rhino.
- ▶ The vet will then administer the antidote to reverse the anaesthetic, to awaken the Rhino.
- ▶ Guests will then enjoy an almost spiritual experience as the Rhino rises to its feet and wanders off into the African bush.
